## B.C.B.R.A. RACE PACKAGE FAQ'S

Thank you for hosting a BCBRA race. We are grateful for all our race producers. Here is some information we think you will find helpful.

## 1. WHAT SHOULD I KNOW BEFORE I HAVE A RACE?

In regards to hosting a BCBRA barrel race, all information is outlined in the BCBRA rulebook: Articles #8 through to 21.

- 2. CO-APPROVALS? (Article #10)
- 3. DO I HAVE TO BE A MEMBER OF THE B.C.B.R.A. TO HOST A RACE & WHY? (Articles #9 & 10)

Yes, due to insurance purposes. This applies to any and all BCBRA races whether being primary or secondary.

4. WHO DO I SEND ALL MY PAPERWORK & MONIES TO AFTER THE RACE?

- 5. WHEN AM I SUPPOSED TO SEND IN ALL OF THIS PAPERWORK? (Article #11)
- 6. WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF I DON'T SEND IT IN WITHIN 14 DAYS? (Article #11)
- 7. IF FOR SOME REASON I AM CONTACTED AND THE PAPERWORK IS INCOMPLETE OR INCORRECT, WHAT WILL HAPPEN? (Article #11)
- 8. I UNDERSTAND NON-MEMBERS CAN COMPETE AT RACES. WHAT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY IN REGARDS TO THIS? (Article #15)
- 9. MEMBERSHIP LISTS ARE UPDATED ONLY ON A WEEKLY BASIS. PLEASE CHECK THE DATE OF LISTING.
- 10. NON-MEMBER INSURANCE FEE WILL BE CHARGED TO COMPETITORS WHO DO NOT PRODUCE THEIR ATTENDANCE CARD.

  Race promoters are responsible for insuring all competitors are covered by insurance. If the competitor cannot produce their attendance card as proof of membership, they must be charged the \$5.00 fee, otherwise this becomes the responsibility of the race promoter. This can be refunded at the next race upon presentation of card with the proper activation date.
- 11. CAN MEMBERSHIPS BE PURCHASED AT RACES? (Articles #1 & 9)

No. Memberships must be in place prior to competing at a B.C.B.R.A race.

- 12. ARE THERE ANY PERSON(S) INELIGIBLE TO COMPETE AT B.C.B.R.A SANCTIONED RACES? (Article #6 & 9)
- 13. CAN I CANCEL THE RACE IF ONLY 1 MEMBER SHOWS UP? (Article #19)
- 14. CAN I CANCEL THE RACE IF BAD WEATHER IS FORECASTED OR THERE IS AN "EXTRAORDINARY CIRCUMSTANCE? (Article #19)
- 15. WHEN AM I SUPPOSED TO DO THE PAYOUT? (Article #16)
- 16. WHAT SHOULD I KNOW IN REGARDS TO PREPARING FOR A RACE?
  - a. <u>BE ON TIME</u>. If the start time says 10 a.m., you should start well within that time. Competitors have often driven a long way, and expect to compete at the advertised start time. You will not get repeat competitors if they have to wait for a long time.
  - b. Have enough volunteers to help you. You will need someone to mark the pattern, take entries & do payout, run the gate, operate the ground equipment, announce and record times.
  - c. Pattern should be marked & in place well in advance.
  - d. You must rake every 5 riders.
  - e. The B.C.B.R.A. is not responsible for miscalculation of payouts. If in doubt, check the "cheat sheet" or if you can operate excel, you can request a copy of the calculator from the Sec/Treasurer.
  - f. If a seperate judge is not available, then the arena manager takes on this position. The Arena Manager (&/or Judge) has to be aware and provide her /(his) undivided attention to each and individual competition run.
  - g. Guidelines are set out for re-runs. Any situations outside these guidelines are subject to the Arena Manager's discretion.
- 17. WHAT SHOULD BE CHARGED FOR ARENA FEES/TIMER FEES/ENTRY FEES? (Article #15)
- 18. WHICH SEASON DO RACES THAT ARE BETWEEN THE FINALS CUT-OFF AND THE FINALS COUNT FOR? (ARTICLE #9)
- 19. WHOM DO I CALL IF I HAVE ANY FURTHER QUESTIONS IN REGARDS TO PUTTING ON A RACE?
