BCRA & BCBRA INELIGIBLE LISTS: Honouring of these lists have been revisited and this is the new administration. Any outstanding fines, dues, etc, owing to either association **MUST be paid prior to, to be eligible to enter the BCBRA finals.**

ADMINISTRATION: All questions and concerns must be made in writing, signed by the person of concern, and delivered to the office

BCBRA OFFICE

The office will open at 4 p.m. (September 12, 2024 Thursday)

It is your responsibility to ensure all monies owed are paid prior to your arrival at the finals.

CAMPING(DRY)

Camping is \$10 per night/per rig.

STALL RENTAL \$25.00 PER NIGHT/PER HORSE; PEN RENTAL \$10 PER NIGHT/PER HORSE. SELF-PENNING(YOUR SETUP) \$6.00 PER NIGHT/PER HORSE

Pens are limited and therefore reservations NEED to be made!

- If you get to the grounds and do not wish the pens booked, **YOU DO NOT GET A REFUND.** You must inform stall management that you are not using the pen. If the pen is used and not cleaned you will be responsible for the pen cleaning! If you sell the pen, please inform the stall manager so that you are no longer responsible.
- All pens are pre-assigned. Any attempt to change pen locations **WITHOUT PRIOR PERMISSION** from stall management will result in a \$25 fine.
- Stalls **MUST** be cleaned to the ground – nothing can be left behind
- **Please clean up your manure and garbage before leaving. (Garbage MUST be placed in containers provided)**
- There will be no stall deposits – it is based on the honour system. Stalls and pens will be looked at once weekend is over, and you will be charged \$25 if your pen/stall is found dirty.
- **SELF-PENNING: IMPORTANT!!!! Self-Pens will be restricted to 12 feet x 12 feet.**

HAUL-IN FEE:

- For those not renting stalls/pens/self-penning, there will be a one-time haul-in fee of \$10. **All manure & garbage is to be taken with you!**

VOLUNTEER LIST (ARENA HELP)

- Please check for your name on the volunteers list for arena help. If you are unable to make that time it is your responsibility to find a substitute. The list will be posted on our website and at the office.
- Members who fail to show up or provide a replacement for designated jobs will receive a \$50 fine.
- All fines must be paid in full before the end of the day. Unpaid fines will result in suspension of further race privileges.

FINALS ENTRY FORM:

- If entry form &/or payment is incorrect or incomplete (excluding overpayment) YOU WILL BE SUBJECT TO A \$20 ADDITIONAL PROCESSING FEE! (Does not apply to extra pen nights)
- Use Canada Post service only. NO Purolator, Loomis or similar service.
- **NO CHEQUES!!! Only money orders, EMT or drafts accepted! NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- All Open, Junior and Senior competitors are required to bring a sponsorship of \$50. Peewee competitors must bring a \$20 sponsorship. This is per rider, not horse or category. This must be in the form of cash or cheque only. However, if you have obtained sponsorship for a blanket, saddle, or buckle this \$50 (&/or \$20) is waived. Leadlines are exempt.
- If paying by etransfer, the member's name MUST be in the Memo field. The entry will NOT be accepted if the Memo field is blank.

ORDER OF GO

- An order of go will be posted on the BCBRA website, Saturday Prior to the finals. Confirm your draw by actual office posting.

DRESS CODE AND HAT FINES

- Western attire, includes western hats (exception: safety helmets), proper riding boots and western shirts. Shirts must have a collar and cuffs. Blue jeans are acceptable, but free from rips and tears.
- Loss of hats in the arena or alleyway during competition will result in a \$20 fine (each time hat is lost). All hat fines MUST be paid before you make your next run. There will be a Director at the in gate and you will not be able to run until your hat fine is paid.

AS PER GENERAL RULES:

- All contesting horses shall be entirely free from effects of stimulants or hypnotics. Contestants will be subject to suspension if found abusing this rule.
- All items that are not in the Notes to Competitors will default to the BCBRA rules currently in place.

SLACK /TRADE OUTS: Will be accepted up to Tuesday (September 10th) at 4 p.m.

- Once the draw is posted there will be an allowance of 72 hours (3days) to contact the entry office to request trade outs/slack with the following stipulations:
 - Must have valid reason for requesting trade (slack is rodeo related only) and must be in writing (email accepted)
 - Must have made arrangements with the person you would like to trade with.
 - Must be run on the same day (slack and trade outs).
 - Trade outs do not need to be restricted to the same rake order.

HORSE CHANGE REQUEST: Will be accepted up to and no later than 8 p.m. Thursday (September 12th)

NO REFUNDS EXCEPT FOR VET &/OR MEDICAL RELEASE(S): RELEASES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED BY EMAILING: bcbrafinals@gmail.com

- Vet releases may be subject to verification by the vet in question
- Any and all Releases will be accepted only up to Thursday (September 12) noon. It is your responsibility to ensure the release is received by the ENTRY SECRETARY ONLY at bcbrafinals@gmail.com
- Refunds will be issued after the finals are complete.
 - Signed (vet &/or physician) releases with 7 days notice prior to the start of finals will receive a refund for entry fees/pen reservations less office fees and sponsorships.
 - Releases with less than 7 days notice, will receive a refund as previously stated but no refund on pen reservations. This does not include off site stalling. Please contact those owners.
- Injury to horse &/or rider during competition. **NO SUBSTITUTIONS** of horses for the remaining goes. Will get a refund of entries less office fee(s) for the go's not completed.

COMPETITION RUN

- Once you have entered the arena, there will be no circling prior to the start of the competition run (inside the arena).
- 3 minute rule. If the rider has not crossed the line within 3 mins, rider will be asked to leave the arena and will receive NT
- No schooling – no redoing the pattern. You MUST complete your run at the same pace you begin.
- There will be no uncinching, taking tack off, or scoring in the alleyway/in gate.

AWARDS PRESENTATION

- Will be held under the big white tent. Please give us 2 hours after the final run, so we may send you home with cheques and awards plus give everyone time to pack up and clean up
- Peeweeps will be paid out in cash this year at the awards presentation – any Peewee not present will get contacted for pay out
- If you will not be attending the award ceremony and will be receiving an award/money, you MUST fill out a form at the office
