 Motion by Joyce Pifer to amend rule "Appropriate fees will need to be paid for each additional horse" to "An additional fee of \$30 per horse will be charged and will be included on the entry form at the time when entering the finals."

- 2. Motion by Joyce Pifer to add to rulebook "All those attending a BCBRA race that is co-approved and do not pay the co-approval fee will then be a member not in good standing and will be placed on the ineligible list. Should the member declare it was paid to the hosting race producer, it is up to the member to provide proof of payment.
- 3. Motion by Melisa Sandberg to add to rulebook "When entering, a competitor must name a horse no using "Horse #1", "Horse #2" etc."
- 4. Motion by Shaylene Tucker to add to rule "A horse may only be entered a maximum of one contestant in the Open and/or Senior category on a race day. The same horse may only be entered by a maximum of two contestants in the Junior and/or Peewee category on the same race day. A horse cannot exceed four runs in the given day. Riders may not enter on the same horse if also riding a second horse. (Lead line is exempt)."
- 5. Motion by Bridget Rosette to add to rulebook "draws for races must be random. If a digital format is not available, an alternate format must be utilized (ex. names on paper in a bucket)"
- 6. Discussion by Judy Hyde to having our Finals mid-summer (end of July/beginning of August) so we are not in conflict with the a) last rodeos of the year where some are trying to make rodeo finals; b) ABRA Finals which is the same weekend this year; c) it's nice to have it earlier so the futurity/derby horses are not getting their 3-day weekends all clumped together.
- 7. Discussion by Judy Hyde to amend Finals rule to allow walking your horse into the alley and uncinching during the rake after your run.
- 8. Discussion by Jude Hyde to delete 3-minute rule to get your horse in the arena after your name has been called or be disqualified from the Finals rules.
- 9. Motion by Kim Meise to add to rulebook "A Peewee can run in the Open at a regular season jackpot (not at Finals) without endangering their Peewee card, but they may not run in the Peewee and Open categories at said jackpot."
- 10. Discussion by Kim Meise to change current Peewee Finals format from 1 run on Friday and 2 runs on Saturday to either eliminate a Saturday run and have the Peewees have a two-run average, or to have them run on Sunday.
